

## CACHE LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR CHEMSEP™

RETURN ONE EXECUTED COPY OF THIS AGREEMENT TO:

1. CACHE grants to LICENSEE a fully-paid, non-exclusive, and non-transferable license to use the computer software CHEMSEP and associated documentation furnished hereunder (hereinafter called the "Program") upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set out until Licensee discontinues use of the Licensed Program and returns or destroys all copies.
2. LICENSEE agrees to pay to CACHE an initial royalty license fee of One Hundred (100.00)/(One Hundred Fifteen (115.00) for departments not CACHE members) Dollars for the license. Subsequently, at the beginning of each additive year of use, LICENSEE will pay CACHE Sixty Dollars (60.00)/(Seventy-five Dollars (75.00) for departments not CACHE members) for the right to continue to use and duplicate CHEMSEP for students.
3. LICENSEE acknowledges that the Program is a research tool still in the development stage, that it is being supplied "as is," without any accompanying services or improvements from CACHE, and that this license is entered into in order to encourage scientific collaboration.
4. CACHE MAKES NO REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED. By way of example, but not limitation, CACHE MAKES NO REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR ANY PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR THAT THE USE OF THE LICENSED SOFTWARE COMPONENTS OR DOCUMENTATION WILL NOT INFRINGE ANY PATENTS, COPYRIGHTS, TRADEMARKS OR OTHER RIGHTS. CACHE shall not be held liable for any direct, indirect or consequential damages with respect to any claim by LICENSEE or any third party on account of or arising from this Agreement or use of the Program.
5. LICENSEE agrees that it will use the Program solely for academic purposes and shall not distribute or transfer it to any nonacademic person without prior written permission from CACHE. The software may be installed and operated on any personal computer that is located at the academic site. The licensed site is granted a non-exclusive License to use the Program in work related to academic courses run by, at, or on behalf of the academic institutions. For convenience, instructors as employees of the Institution accepting the terms of this site license, are granted the right to install this software on up to two additional machines for use away from the academic site. This right does not extend to students. This license does not permit the use of this software for any commercial purposes (even by instructors) or for private consulting.
6. Title and copyright to the Program and to any material associated therewith shall at all times remain with the authors of CHEMSEP, and LICENSEE agrees to preserve same. LICENSEE agrees not to use any portion of the Program in any machine-readable form outside the Program, nor to make any copies except for its academic use, without prior written consent of CACHE. LICENSEE agrees to place the appropriate copyright notice on any such copies.
7. This Agreement is governed by the laws of the Netherlands and the intellectual property laws of the Netherlands. No party to this Agreement will bring a legal action under this Agreement more than one year after the cause of action arose. Any legal action arising out of this Agreement or use of the Program shall be filed in a court in The Netherlands.
8. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed as conferring rights to use in advertising, publicity or otherwise any trademark or the name of "CACHE."

The undersigned, as a representative of the academic site, acknowledges that he/she has read the entire agreement and agrees to abide by the terms and conditions as stated above. The undersigned further agrees that it is the complete and exclusive statement of the agreement between us which supersedes any proposal or prior agreement, oral or written, and any other communications between us relating to the subject matter herein.
